

# Ending AIDS in Children

## Results in countries where the Joint Programme on HIV and AIDS operates

75

countries had a national plan for the elimination of vertical transmission of HIV

86

countries implemented the 'treat all' policy for pregnant and breastfeeding women

64

countries had integrated HIV services for children into at least 50% of primary health-care sites

**16** Countries were validated for the elimination of vertical transmission of HIV including Oman (2022) and Belize (2023)  
Namibia gained 'bronze tier' certification on the path to eliminating HIV (2023)

**90+** Countries were procuring paediatric dolutegravir for children
