




Domestic public expenditures by region, 2005-2013













Reductions in new HIV infections and AIDSrelated deaths, 1996-2013








AIDS epidemic remains a huge issue

In 2013:

- 35 M people living with HIV
- 19 M people don't know their status
- 22 M are not receiving ART
- 2.1 M people newly infected
- 1.5 M people died of AIDS related causes
- Stigma and discrimination persist




UNAIDS Role

- **Supporting** country leadership for sustainable responses integrated with national health and development efforts.


UNAIDS Core Contributions by Biennia 2010-2015
